

SADOFF & RUDOY INDUSTRIES, LLP MATERIAL ACCEPTANCE POLICY

Sadoff & Rudoy Industries, LLP is committed to the health and safety of its employees and customers as well as to conducting an environmentally safe and clean operation. Therefore, we cannot accept items that present a threat to human health or the environment. Such items include, but are not necessarily limited to, the following:

- 1. CAPACITORS OR CAPACITOR BEARING MATERIALS:** Items that once contained capacitors will be accepted only if all capacitors have been removed (in compliance with all state and federal regulations), and the seller has supplied Sadoff with written certification of removal and indemnification.
- 2. BALLASTS OR ITEMS CONTAINING BALLASTS (PCB OR NOT):** Items that once contained ballasts will be accepted only if all ballasts have been removed (in compliance with all state and federal regulations), and the seller provides Sadoff with written certification of removal and indemnification.
- 3. LIGHT BULBS:** Including but not limited to fluorescent, neon, halogen, and incandescent.
- 4. SEALED UNITS:** Including but not limited to propane tanks, freon tanks, hydraulic cylinders, air tanks, and units under pressure or containing oils. Units are acceptable if cut open and properly cleaned.
- 5. COMPRESSED GAS & OXYGEN BOTTLES:** Bottles will be accepted if drained, properly cleaned, and one end has been removed.
- 6. LP TANKS:** Must be completely purged and/or shot blasted to remove all residual chemicals and cut in half.
- 7. GAS TANKS:** Gas tanks will be accepted only if they are drained, punched with a minimum of six holes on each side, separate on a load, and arrangement has been made with a Sadoff buyer in advance of delivery.

- 9. TELEVISION SETS**
- 10. TIRES:** Sadoff reserves the right to charge for the handling of tires mixed in a scrap load.

- 11. AUTOMOBILES:** Unless properly decommissioned and have proper documentation.
- 12. NICKEL-CADMIUM, LITHIUM, ABSOLYTE BATTERIES:** This includes all batteries that are not of a lead-acid nature.
- 13. AIRBAG CANISTERS:** Any canister that is not spent, or may contain an unspent propellant such as sodium azide.
- 14. DIRT / SOILS**
- 15. TRANSFORMERS:** Any units that are oil based, unless cleaned and certified free of PCB's, or are of a nonmetallic nature (PCB or not).
- 16. ASBESTOS:** In any form, including any items that contain asbestos (i.e., pipe, wire, etc.).
- 17. MERCURY:** In any form, or contained in any item, e.g. automobile switches (hood and truck switches), appliance switches, temperature switches, pressure switches, position/motion switches, or other liquid mercury bearing devices.
- 18. BARRELS, DRUMS OR CONTAINERS:** That have not been properly cleaned and/or contain any residual material. Skinned coatings that are nonhazardous and have been dried (baked) are acceptable.
- 19. USED OIL FILTERS:** Will be accepted only if complete incineration has occurred, or non-metallics have been removed and the steel washed to remove all oil by a certified processor.
- 20. OILS:** Free flowing oils of any kind including any item that contains the oil unless the oil has been properly removed.
- 21. CHLOROFLUORCARBONS (CFC's):** Any item containing CFC's, hydrochlorofluorcarbons (HCFC's) or substitute refrigerants (air conditioners, refrigerators, compressors, etc.) will be rejected unless the CFC's have been completely removed by a licensed dealer in compliance with all state and federal laws, and proper documentation has been supplied and is on file at Sadoff Iron & Metal Company.
- 22. AMMUNITION:** Any item that contained an explosive charge (whether spent or not).
- 23. EXPLOSIVES:** Of any kind including containers that held explosive materials that have not been properly cleaned.
- 24. RADIOACTIVE MATERIAL:** All grades of scrap must be free of radioactive materials or radiation sources. The presence of radioactive scrap is grounds for complete rejection in compliance with all state and federal regulations.
- 25. NON-METALLICS:** Not acceptable including but not limited to garbage, concrete, tar, paper, rags, wood, food products, and plastic.

- 26. FUEL STORAGE TANKS:** Not acceptable unless they have been cut open and cleaned by a certified dealer, and are free of coatings such as tar, plastic, resin, ceramic, etc.
- 27. METALLIC SLUDGES AND DROSSES:** Not acceptable unless the seller can provide appropriate documentation that the material is not hazardous, and it has been managed in compliance with applicable legal standards.
- 28. HAZARDOUS MATERIAL:** Not acceptable in any form including but not limited to chemicals, toxic or combustible materials, paints, acids, pesticides, etc. (as defined by any applicable local, state or federal requirement), or any item attached to or containing such materials.
- 29. BAGHOUSE DUST:** Not acceptable in any form.
- 30. WHITEGOODS:** Unless all CFC's, hydrochlorofluorocarbons (HCFC's) or substitute refrigerants, ammonia, and other hazardous materials have been removed by a licensed dealer (in compliance with all state and federal regulations), and the dealer has supplied Sadoff with written certification and indemnification.
- 31. MACHINERY:** Unless free of capacitors, pressurized hoses, drained of oils, excessive grease, and any other banned items.
- 32. CIRCUIT BOARDS:** Only if delivered as a separate item. Cannot be left in computers, appliances, etc.
- 33. WHEEL WEIGHTS:** May be delivered as a separate item, or as an attachment to rims used as a shredder item. May not be attached to rims delivered as foundry steel.
- 34. CHLORINATED OR HALOGENATED CUTTING OILS, LUBRICANTS, OR ADDITIVES:** Any product or component containing these items is banned and will be returned to the generator at the generator's expense.

Sadoff & Rudoy Industries, LLP is neither a licensed hazardous waste hauler, nor hazardous waste disposal site. Any hazardous material or item will be returned to the generator in full compliance with all state and federal rules and regulation. All costs related to handling and returns will be at the generator's expense.
